To cultivate a comprehensive comprehension of digital citizenship and promote safer and more responsible online conduct among children, it is imperative to implement measures that facilitate a well-rounded knowledge of digital use.

Music possesses a distinct capacity to captivate the attention of youngsters by employing repetitious lyrics and a catchy melody, so rendering their learning experience entertaining and facilitating the retention of transmitted contents within the song. The song serves to reaffirm fundamental tenets of digital citizenship, including promoting online safety, protecting privacy, and cultivating polite conduct towards other internet users. Additionally, the programme emphasises the importance of internet etiquette and manners, promoting the notion that children should provide the same level of respect and consideration to people online as they would in face-to-face interactions. The song further emphasises the importance of parents actively instructing individuals on how to navigate the internet realm securely and responsibly. It is essential to foster practical communication skills among children and instil in them the need to seek permission before utilising electronic gadgets. Refraining from bringing electronic displays into bed is a commendable habit that contributes to preserving healthy sleep patterns and overall well-being (ECA, 2018).



Digital gadgets, such as the iPad, undoubtedly pleasure children. However, it is essential to acknowledge that these devices expose children to unforeseen and potentially distressing information, impacting their emotional well-being. The absence of adult supervision and direction can have a detrimental impact on the emotional well-being of individuals.

Children's sense of security and safety is enhanced when they have access to trusted people who can assist in situations when they have witnessed or encountered distressing content through their electronic devices.





Establishing constructive communication channels between children and adults facilitates the children's ability to seek assistance when required. Additionally, it is beneficial for adults to be knowledgeable about their children's difficulties when using digital tools.

Consequently, he elects to discontinue viewing the footage, promptly deactivates the iPad, and actively seeks guidance from adult figures. Establishing guidelines for the use of digital technology is a crucial measure in facilitating children's comprehension of both the advantageous and detrimental consequences that may arise from its improper usage. Touchscreen devices allow children to independently access online information across several digital platforms, like Swoosh, without requiring adult assistance. However, this unrestricted access exposes them to potential risks associated with unsuitable content, compromising their sense of safety.

Therefore, providing secure online experiences for children within their homes cultivates citizenship values such as respect, tolerance, and the avoidance of discrimination. Additionally, it facilitates the development of pro-social behaviour and creates possibilities for learning (ECA, 2018).

Kiya's Birthday









Literary Analysis

According to Fellowes and Oakley (2019), the visual representations in the book effectively communicate the narrative depicted in the written content. Children's comprehension of patterns and design is augmented when they recognise these components through artistic representations and the use of colours within the narrative. The narrative depicting a chicken's unauthorised entry into the farmer's abode and subsequent utilisation of a computer imparts valuable lessons about

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appropriate conduct to young individuals.

The chicken experiences a sense of excitement and satisfaction through online shopping, acquiring various items for personal use and the benefit of fellow farm inhabitants. This activity is closely associated with the realm of digital commerce. Children must comprehend the importance of developing practical consumer skills within the digital economy, as highlighted by the International Society for Technology in Education (ISTE, 2022, as cited in Michlmayr, 2023, p. 19). The individual's heightened emotional state motivates her to establish a connection with a novel acquaintance, covertly instigating a desire to arrange an in-person encounter. However, it transpires that he encounters the astute fox, which unveils the perils associated with internet connections for children. Furthermore, it fosters the development of critical thinking skills in children by prompting them to reflect on the potential consequences of their activities inside digital environments. Including narratives such as the one mentioned in the context of Early Childhood Education can contribute to cultivating digital literacy competencies among young learners. This, in turn, empowers them to traverse the digital realm with a sense of responsibility effectively, make well-informed choices, and engage in online interactions securely (AGDE, 2022).

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
